Daniel Esty

Director of the Yale Centre for Environmental Law and Policy at Yale University. Daniel is a former US government senior official and policy adviser to the US Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). He has written numerous books and articles on environmental policy issues and the relationships between the environment and trade, security, competitiveness, international institutions, business and development.

Ma Jun is a specialist on water. Author of *China's Water Crisis*, a book describing the flooding and pollution of the country's water resources, he also led the development of a public database detailing China's water quality in 31 provinces. In 2009 Jonathon stood down after nine years as Chairman of the UK's Sustainable Development Commission, the government's principal source of independent advice on sustainable development.
